



Dear Neighbours,

I hope you are all well.

As our ongoing commitment to keeping you updated on activities happening at Cundy Street Quarter, I would like to advise that Museum of London Archaeology will be undertaking archeological investigations starting on Monday 28th of November for approximately 1 week.





Museum of London Archaeology will have an appointed office based manager who will have an overall responsibility for the project. They will also have a site based site supervisor, responsible for the direction of the field team, along with archaeological staff that are responsible for the borehole excavations.





On-site methodology

- Starter pits will be hand-dug to circa 1.2m depth at each borehole location
- Boreholes will then be drilled using a small 1m wide rig under the supervision of a MOLA archaeologist
- The samples collected are held in 1m long plastic tubes
- The archaeologists will keep a field log of the boreholes and a photographic record of the site and cores
- All borehole locations will be reinstated once works are completed
