Dear Neighbours,

Hope you are all doing well.

Since our last Newsletter issued in January we have completed the **Temporary UKPN substation** that will be handed over to UKPN for their installation and commissioning works.






We will commence the following at the end of February and beginning of March:

- 1. **Gas disconnection to all 4 no buildings.** These works will entail the gas disconnection of the four buildings from the gas main pipes. All works will occur within site boundary and will start from Monday 20th of February for a duration of 2 weeks.
- 2. Main demolition works.
 - I. Scaffold construction. As mentioned in previous newsletter, we will start preparing for the main demolition works. The first activity that will facilitate demolition works to

commence is the construction of scaffold enclosures to all four buildings. These enclosures will reduce any potential noise and dust arising from demolition works to spread outside site boundary and provide us with safe environment to work within.. Deliveries will be arriving to site from the end of February and will continue throughout the duration of the works with Cundy St gate being used for most deliveries/collections whilst Ebury St Gate will be used by exception for lorries that can't turn onto Cundy St

II. Demolition Works. These works will only commence once the scaffold enclosures around the buildings are constructed. However, there will be some minor demolition activities on site concurrently with scaffold installation. These minor demolition works will facilitate installation of welfare site cabins within Walden House former garages and other works to facilitate site logistics. These works will be undertaken by small excavator and will be undertaken towards the back end of March 2023.
